Fishing Tournament

Fishing Times: 6:00 a.m. Thursday to 4:00 p.m. Saturday
Weight Station Location: Bridge Side Marina, Grand Isle, LA
Weigh-In Times: Friday 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. / Saturday 12 Noon to 4:00 p.m.

NOTES: • A PERSON CAN WIN ONLY ONE AWARD PER FISHING CATEGORY.

- All fishing categories will be awarded on weight. Ties by weight, will be decided by the first fish entered.
- Each person must have their own ticket and must be present to weigh-in their own fish.
- All decisions of the Weight Master are final.
- Fishing Categories apply only if in season. All Federal, State and Local Laws must be obeyed.

Fishing Divisions and Categories are:

 Bull Red (*must be over 27" long*)
 Speckled Trout

Fishing Entries:

- Adults (over age 12) holding and Adult/Open Division ticket must enter in the Adult/Open Division only.
- Children (under age 12) holding a Child's ticket must enter a fish in the Children's Division only.
- Children (under age 12) holding an Adult/Open Division ticket must enter in the Adult/Open Division only.
- Adult/Open Division ticket is required to enter a fish in the Kayak Division
- Kayak Division allows human powered craft only. Trolling motors, sails, gas engines, and "mother ships", are not allowed. Pedal and paddle crafts must be human powered, and includes but is not limited to kayaks, canoes, pirogues, and SUPs (stand up paddleboards). Tandem human powered crafts are permitted.
- More detailed rules, if modified, will be posted at the scales.

Prizes will be awarded for the **first 3 places in each category**; for the **Best Overall Adult/Open Division**; for the **Best Overall Fisherette**; for the **Best Overall Children's Division**; and for the **Best Overall Boat**.

The Best Overall will be determined by a point system (3 pts. for 1st place, 2 pts. for second place, and 1 pt. for third place). A point tie will be decided by the most 1st places. If a tie still exists, the committee will use total weight to break the tie.
